## MANUSCRIPT FORM

**TITLE:** The original title and the English translation must be in the paper (**Times New Roman 14**)

**ABSTRACTS (no more than 250 words and five keywords) Times New Roman 11**

- Articles written in English: abstract in English, French, Spanish and Portuguese.
- Articles written in French: abstract in French, Spanish, Portuguese, and English.
- Articles written in Spanish: abstract in Spanish, French, Portuguese and English.
- Articles written in Portuguese: abstract in Portuguese, French, Spanish, and English.

**We request that all authors carefully review the abstract, resumen, resumo and résumé**
